APPLICATION FOR VARIOUS CUSTOMS LICENCES LICENSING OF CUSTOMS BONDED WAREHOUSES, TRANSIT GODOWNS, DUTY FREE SHOPS AND CUSTOMS BONDED FACTORIES (MUBs)

Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) wishes to remind all operators of the above facilities that their licences will expire on 31st December 2009.

Interested parties for both new and renewal of the licences are advised to submit their applications through the respective Customs Regional Offices where the facilities are situated so as to reach the Headquarters (Times Towers) by 30th September 2009, in compliance with the requirements of the East African Community Customs Management Act, 2004 as read together with the East African Community Customs Management Regulations, 2006.

The following documents/information must be attached to the application. -

- a) Tax Compliance certificate from Domestic Taxes Department.
- b) Confirmation of the current directors of the company.
- c) Possession of valid Security Bonds- CB6.
- d) Clearance report by the Regional offices.
- e) Data showing average monthly output in terms of duties and taxes for the last twelve months
- f) Return of goods lying in the facility as at 30th June, 2009

Applications for licensing of the above Customs Facilities received after 30th September 2009 will only be accepted for consideration upon payment of late application fee of Kshs 10,000.
